Dispatch Center

- Dispatchers busy with high call volume
- 911 Calls
- Tipsters hear radio background noise and fear their anonymity
- Fear the call is being recorded
- Training of dispatch personnel
- Change in personnel
- Caller ID show within the dispath center



Answering Machines/Voicemails


- Anonymity
- Voice Recording of Tipster
- Loss of Important Tips
 - Tipster does not feel comfortable leaving information
 - Tipster does not call back



Answered by Departmental Officers

- Understaffed departments
- Handling calls tips while out of the office
- Importance of keeping callers and tip information anonymous
- Handling of urgent calls/mobile tips during non-working hours
 - Family time/Vacations
 - Court appearances
 - On scene/working cases
 - Nighttime
 - Entering data into P3

Second, our Scholastic Crime
Stoppers program is credited with
preventing it's 11th suicide after a TIP
was received that included a copy of
the suicide note (as an attachment)
that had been posted on social media.
This was a first as school is not in
session yet an anonymous tipster still
utilized our program. Also need to
credit Crime Scene Information who in
addition to contacting me also
contacted the police with the
information saving valuable time!



Protecting Informant Identity

- Do not accept the name of the Tipster
- Do not disclose gender of the Tipster
- Do not Call, trace, or record any calls
- Do not include geographical references: next door neighbor etc.
